

### Literacy:

- We will continue to practise our reading and phonics skills daily.
- We will look at fiction texts including 'The Enormous Crocodile (Roald Dahl) using Talk for Writing .



### Maths:

- We will count in 2s, 5s and 10s backwards and forwards.
- We will read and write two-digit numbers and show what each digit stands for.
- We will write numbers in order and position them on a number line.
- We will compare numbers using the greater than, less than and equal to symbols.

### Science:

- We will look at the basic needs of animals and their offspring.
- We will explore simple food chains and habitats.
- We will compare the differences between things that are living, dead and things that have never been alive.
- We will think about what humans need to survive.
