

Literacy:

We will continue to practise our reading and phonics skills daily.
We will work on forming all lower and upper case letters correctly.
We will also look at fiction texts such as Stick Man (Julia Donaldson), Hansel and Gretel.
We will read a selection of weather poems and create our own.
We will work on writing simple sentences, remembering capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. To improve our sentences we will use connectives such as and, but, because, so.

Science:

We will observe the changes across the four seasons focusing particularly on the weather.
We will compare and classify materials.
We will ask simple scientific questions and carry out a simple experiment.

PSHE:

My emotions
We will be able to give names to a number of different feelings.
We will say how we are feeling.
We will be able to recognise feelings in others.

Geography:

We will explain how the weather changes throughout the year and name the seasons.
We will keep a weather chart and answer questions about the weather.
We will be able to explain some of the main things that are in hot and cold places.
We will be able to talk about the clothes that we would wear in hot and cold places.
We will explain where we live and tell someone our address.

Art/DT:

We will name the primary and secondary colours and use these to create winter scenes.
We will use IT to create a picture of a hot or cold place and what might be found there.

P.E.

We will throw underarm.

Maths:

We will count forwards and backwards and write numbers to 20 and beyond in numerals and words.
Given a number, we will identify the number one more or one less.
We will count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10.
We will identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than.
We will compare, describe and solve practical problems for lengths and heights.

ICT:

We will keep personal information private.
We will use a camera.
We will be able to use a web site.
We will create a series of instructions.
We will record sound and playback.
