

### **Pupil Premium 2012 – 2013**

In 2012/13 the level of premium was £623 per pupil. The school allocation was £99,057. Impact of provision - expected progress is 3 points per year

All year groups made at least good progress in reading, writing and maths.

At the end of key stage 1, 15 points is the expected level of attainment for all pupils. The gap between PP pupils and age-related expectation has closed over the last three years in reading, writing and maths.

At the end of key stage 2, 27 points is the expected level of attainment for all pupils. The gap between PP pupils and age-related expectation has closed over the last three years in reading, writing and maths. In 2013 PP pupils exceeded age-related expectations in maths.

### **2012 - 2013 Provision Cost**

- SLT member responsible for 'Narrowing the gap'. - Identification and implementation of strategies, use of funding, evaluation of provision and impact + Parent Support Partner - supporting families to increase attendance, engagement and achievement. £39,032
- Raising standards interventions - additional 1:1 intervention and small group support in English and Maths; additional adults for small group support and interventions alongside quality first teaching in the mornings; additional targeted interventions in the afternoons £41,874
- ELSA/Forest School leader - provide focused social and emotional support for learning and the resources required for effective support of the pupils. £8,834
- Curriculum enrichment and wellbeing experiences -support for day residential experiences and transport to ensure equality of access to opportunities. £5,218
- Speech, language and communication -screening of EYFS and other groups to identify vulnerable groups; supported in class, through targeted intervention. £2,394
- Collaborative learning - promote a positive attitude to learning by increasing engagement, independence and peer support. £1,044
- ICT additional ICT resources to enrich learning and increase pupil enthusiasm for, and engagement in learning. £5,227
