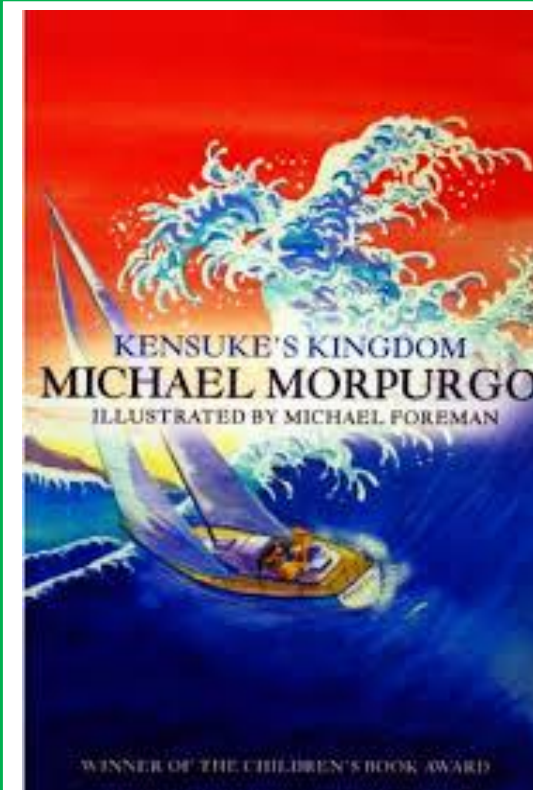


### Literacy

- Identify how language, structure and presentation contribute to meaning
- Select appropriate grammar and vocabulary
- Use dictionaries to check the spelling and meaning of unfamiliar vocabulary

## Stranded

Year 5's Stranded topic will be based on the book *Kensuke's Kingdom* by Michael Morpurgo. They will follow the main character's journey around the world and become stranded on a desert island.

### Science

The Science topic this half term is Animals including humans. Year 5 will be learning about changes as humans develop from birth to old age.

### Geography

Year 5 are going to locate the world's countries using atlases and computer mapping to plot the journey to Kensuke's Kingdom.

### DT

Year 5 will generate and model ideas through a variety of mediums using design criteria that will create a suitable shelter. To ensure their shelter design is fit for purpose, we will evaluate plans and consider their effectiveness.

### Homework

### Maths: Shape and measures

- Identify 3D shapes from 2D representations
- Use the properties of rectangles to deduce related facts and find missing lengths and angles
- Distinguish between regular and irregular polygons based on reasoning about equal sides and angles
- Know angles and measured in degrees
- Estimate and compare angles
- Draw given angles and measure them in degrees
