Literacy Development:

We will focus on the story of 'Jack and the Beanstalk.'

We will continue to focus on creating and adapting stories using story mountains.

We will be focusing on recognising tricky words and alien words. We will be writing our own story mountains.

We will write for different purposes such as: labels, captions, speech bubbles, instructions etc.

Understanding the World

We will comment and ask questions about the natural world-learning about growing.

We will look closely at the changes that happen to seeds and plants when they grow.

We will learn new topic vocabulary: seed, root, stem, leaf, petal, plant, seedling, soil, growing.

We will use computers to retrieve information- using a search engine to find out facts about growing.

We will input instructions on a beebot to get it to move to a specific location.

<u>/orld</u>

We will recognise and order numerals up to 20 and beyond.

Mathematical Development:

We will be ordering and comparing by height, using language of 'tall', 'short', 'taller', 'shorter', 'tallest' and 'shortest.'

We will be ordering and comparing by length, using language of 'long', 'short', 'longer', 'shorter', 'longest' and 'shortest.'

We will be learning about time and using everyday language related to time.

We will be counting in groups of 2, 5 and 10.

Communication and language

We will question why things happen and give explanations-talking about how plants grow. We will extend our vocabulary, exploring the meaning of new words linking to our topic of growing, e.g. growing, roots, seed, plant, leaves, stem.

We will create our own set of rules to outline how to safely use the new outdoor areas.


