

Task 1 – Caring for a seed.

You will be given a seed to take home.
Plant your seed and take care of it.

Make sure you look after your seed. Give it all of the things that it needs to grow and be healthy.

Observe your seed closely – draw it, measure it and record your findings. Notice how it changes each day.

Use an old box and collect stones, leaves, twigs etc to make a miniature garden. Top tip – blue tac or playdough helps to keep things still.
