This morning we received confirmation of a positive COVID test. We received confirmation at 8.10am this morning. Due to timeframes, as a precaution, we advised all contacts in the Year 2 bubble not to attend school today.

At the first opportunity, we have contacted the DfE school helpline and Public Health to report the case.

They have asked us questions with regards to contacts, onset of symptoms and when the individual was last on the school site.

Given the responses to these questions, we have now been assured there is no requirement for the bubble to self-isolate. Literacy and maths work has been set for today on School 360. Children may return to school as usual on Monday 28 September.
