Dear Parents/Carers

Following updated information regarding last point of contact with a positive case and more recent advice, we can inform you that the Year 6 isolation period ends on Thursday 19 November at midnight. We wanted to provide you with this update as we do not want Year 6 children out of school any longer than is necessary. Also I am sure the children and staff will appreciate not having to isolate for a second weekend. Year 6 children can now return to school on Friday 20 November.

You may be aware that, as part of contingency planning, we have had to close school to all children at 12.30pm on Friday 13 and 20 November. However, with Year 6 staff now returning with the children on Friday, we will remain open all day for Year 6 children only on Friday 20 November. School remains closed to other year groups on the afternoon of Friday 20 November but we hope to return to normal the following week.

Whilst, I appreciate this is a little complicated it is important we keep missed school due to isolation and contingency planning to a minimum.

All children who receive Free Schools Meals will be provided with a packed lunch. If you wish order a packed lunch for your child on Friday, please order via School Grid.

Finally, well done all Year 6 children and parents who have engaged in the home learning; the Year 6 team of staff have kept me informed on a daily basis.
