Dear Parents/Carers

Schools have been asked by the DfE to be contactable to support track and trace of any positive cases over the half term holiday.

Where a pupil tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19) during the holidays, having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, schools are not required to take any action. Parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

However, where a pupil tests positive having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, the school is asked to assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school. Therefore, if a pupil tests positive on Saturday 29 May or Sunday 30 May please inform us using one of the contacts below immediately.
